

İÇDAŞ Accident Prevention Policy

As İCDAS ÇELİK ENERJİ TERSANE VE ULASTIRMA A.Ş., the fundamental principles of the Accident Prevention Policy to be implemented in harmony with our Quality, Occupational Health and Safety, and Environmental Policies at our Port Facilities are defined as follows: Preventing accidents that may occur during the handling of dangerous goods, ensuring the safety of life, property, and the environment, and minimizing the potential harm of accidents to people and the environment.

Especially During the Handling, Loading, and Unloading of Dangerous Goods:

- To prevent our employees from being injured or exposed to any adverse effects during work accidents,
- To take all necessary measures to ensure safety and security for our employees, customers, stakeholders, and the environment in the working areas of ships and our shore facility,
- To follow a policy of continuous improvement by implementing the best available technologies to prevent accidents,
- To implement appropriate emergency response procedures in the event of an accident, taking measures to minimize and continuously improve the impact of accidents on life, property, and environmental safety,
- To identify all activities at our facility that may cause accidents and to take necessary measures to fulfill the obligations aimed at preventing such accidents,
- To assign personnel who possess appropriate knowledge, skills, training, and experience to critical tasks that affect safety and security in operational work processes,
- To ensure the active participation of employees and employee representatives in all processes of the Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) Management System by incorporating their opinions and suggestions,

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- To obtain the Safety Data Sheet (SDS) for all dangerous goods handled, loaded, or unloaded at the Port Facility, and to thoroughly analyze specific hazard definitions, first aid measures, fire precautions, intervention measures in case of spillage/leakage, special handling conditions (if any), personal exposure precautions, and environmental protection measures, and to take the necessary precautions accordingly,
- To provide the necessary equipment and tools to prevent the potential harmful effects of the dangerous goods,
- To implement appropriate monitoring arrangements and conduct alarm system checks to ensure that the areas where dangerous goods are handled are continuously monitored by relevant facility personnel and/or security officers,
- To ensure sufficient access and exit routes to areas where dangerous goods are handled for effective intervention during emergencies.

We undertake to conduct risk assessments for the identification and evaluation of accidents, to ensure the continuous development of personnel, and to leave a more livable world for future generations by complying with relevant national and international legislation and standards.
